You've heard analysis and opinions from every side. The whole situation leaves me at a loss for words. We are trying to teach our students to “Live for the glory of God and the good of others.”

The last time I wrote about a tragedy (the hurricanes, fires, and earthquakes), my focus was on looking for the helpers. It was a little less daunting because we were talking about natural disasters, not an evil act perpetrated by another human being. But still, look at the people who are helping others.
