A Note from the Principal

"Living for the glory of God and the good of others."

No one can believe how powerful prayer is and what it can effect, except those who have learned it by experience. *Martin Luther*

The quote above is one of many examples of Luther's faith and teaching. This past week I heard Senator Scalise (one of the senators wounded by a gunman during a softball practice back in June) talk about how powerful prayer is. When he was lying on the softball field, he prayed. He talked about how he laid some pretty heavy requests on God at that moment. He went on to say that he that he was "a living example that miracles really do happen." Praise God for his public witness on the floor of the House of Representatives. He is one of the people Martin Luther is talking about – he learned by experience the power of prayer!

We pray with our children daily here at Peace – in fact, many times a day! We don't wait for a tragedy or a disaster to call on our God, and judging from Senator Scalise's comments, he probably doesn't either. The first thing he did when he realized he couldn't move was to turn to God in prayer. Our children are taught that they can bring their requests to God at any time and in any place. We also teach them that prayer is a perfect opportunity to give thanks and praise to God! One of the "tools" we use to teach about prayer is an acronym. A.C.T.S. The letters stand for Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication. These are all things we can talk about with our Heavenly Father.

The teachers and staff of Peace Lutheran are praying for our children and their families every day. We ask that you would lift us up in prayer, too. Pray that we have wisdom and patience as we work with the children in our school. Pray that we are able to reach out to many other children who don't yet know about Jesus. Prayer does indeed change things and bring about miracles!
