A Note from the Principal

"Living for the glory of God and the good of others."

Next week is **THANKSGIVING** and as God's people, we are encouraged to live with an attitude of thanksgiving and praise each day, following Jesus' example. We see this in the Bible story often called "The Feeding of the 5,000."

In reality, Jesus miraculously fed thousands of people, multiplying the meager lunch of two dried fish and five small bread rolls shared by a boy who was among the crowd. Jesus probably took time to thank the boy for sharing His lunch. Then He took it, looked up to heaven and thanked God.

The story continues with Jesus giving this simple meal to His disciples to share with **ALL** the people. And, after everyone had their fill, there were leftovers, possibly for Jesus and His disciples.

Jesus provides for *all* our needs. In the story, Jesus healed many who were sick and provided food, thus meeting their physical needs. Jesus also provided spiritual food. He spent the day talking to them. "He welcomed them and spoke to them of the kingdom of God" (LUKE 9:11). Jesus is the ultimate Provider. He took our place when He suffered, died and came alive again. Because of Jesus' sinless life, we receive forgiveness for our imperfect lives. We will not be punished and under the sentence of eternal death and separation from God. Because of God's ultimate provision, He moves us to respond with praise and thanks. Where to begin?

■ Model and teach your child to be thankful. When someone says something kind, say "Thank you." When someone does something kind, say "Thank you."

■ Before eating, thank God for the food He provides. Here are some prayers:

- God is great; God is good. And we thank Him for our food. Amen.
- Come Lord Jesus, be our guest. Please let these gifts to us be blessed.

Amen

- Bless this food, dear Lord, we pray. Please make us thankful every day.

Amen.

■ At bedtime, thank God for His loving care and protection.
