A Note from the Principal

“Living for the glory of God and the good of others.”

In a recent FaceTime conversation with my 3-year-old granddaughter, her mother said to her, “Tell Grandma what a good attitude is.” She immediately piped up, “It’s one you can bring downstairs!” (That wasn’t really the answer her mother was looking for, but it made me laugh.) Mom then went on to remind her that a good attitude is one of listening and cooperation. Her parents are trying to teach her that no one wants to see pouting or fussing or whining. A good attitude makes your life a lot happier! A good attitude makes others want to spend time with you, too.

In Matthew 5:16 Jesus tells us to have an attitude that we can bring downstairs! Well, He actually put it this way: “In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.” Notice that last part – give glory to your Father who is in heaven! In my granddaughter’s case, her good attitude allows her to join the family downstairs and perhaps go outside and play with a friend. However, as Christians the purpose of letting *our* lights shine is not so that **WE** gain something – it’s so that others will **GIVE GLORY TO OUR FATHER IN HEAVEN**.

When others experience our good attitudes, our kindness and respect for others, and our willingness to help our neighbors, they will give glory to God. If they don’t know about Jesus, you now have an opportunity to share the secret to an “attitude you can bring downstairs.”

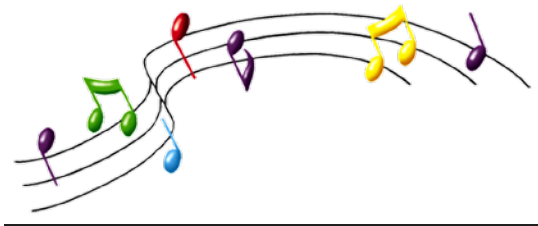
